Now that your child is fully settled into the routines and behaviours expected in Reception, we would like to invite you to a meeting to outline your child's next steps. This is the next part of the transition process for parents and will take place on:

Monday 16th March 2:30pm – 3:00pm in the Small Hall

The meeting will consist of a recap on the **EYFS** Curriculum and how this is divided into 17 aspects, information about the **Early Years Foundation Stage Profile (EYFSP)**, how the **EYFSP** is assessed and what this means in real terms for you and your child with regards to their progress and development now and in the coming months. Your child has been working within the **Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS)** Curriculum towards the **Early Learning Goals** since birth and the end of their year in Reception is where all their learning is assessed as an outcome. Throughout the meeting we will share with you the **EYFSP** national information and how this information supports teachers to enable your child to make a smooth transition into Year 1 to begin to work within the National Curriculum expectations. We will provide you with opportunities to ask questions about the **EYFSP** so that we can continue to work collaboratively towards ensuring the best possible outcomes for your child. Furthermore, we kindly ask you to consider childcare arrangements as this meeting is for parents and carers only. We look forward to meeting you to enable us to continue to work together for the best possible outcomes for your child 😊
