Year 4 Geography Visit to the River Aire

Dear Parents/Guardians,

As part of our Geography learning this term, Year 4 are studying rivers and exploring the features of a local river environment. To support this learning, we would like to take both Year 4 classes on a short fieldwork visit to the River Aire, in Saltaire.

The visits will take place on the following dates:

- 4C: Wednesday 21st October
- 4W: Thursday 22nd October

We will travel by school minibus, leaving school after registration, and will return to school in time for lunch. During the visit, children will walk along the river path to observe and record geographical features. Please note that the children **will not enter the river at any point**.

As the visit will take place outdoors, children should wear their **normal school uniform** along with:

- Comfortable walking shoes or trainers
- A waterproof coat
- Sun hat and sunscreen if warm weather is forecast

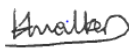
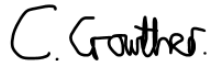
We intend to go ahead with the visit in all but the most extreme weather conditions, so please ensure your child is dressed appropriately on the day.
