Dear Parent/Carer

As part of our Summer 2 History topic, 'Crime and Punishment', Year 5 will be visiting Ripon Museums. During the day, we will visit each of the three museums: Courthouse Museum, Police and Prison Museum and the Workhouse Museum. We will explore each of the museums and take part in specially designed workshops.

The two classes will be attending on **different days**:

5U – Wednesday 24th June

5O – Thursday 25th June

All children will need to bring the following:

- Packed lunch with a drink, including healthy snacks, no fizzy drinks or sweets and please can you ensure that you do not send your child with items of food that contain nuts. Those who are entitled to a free school meals can have a packed lunch ordered for them.
- Raincoats may be needed as we will be walking between the museums.
- Children will need to be in their school uniform.

Travel Arrangements will be as follows:

As we are travelling to Ripon in minibuses, and wish to allow for traffic, please arrive at school for **8.00am** so we can set off promptly, no later than 8.15am. Dependent on traffic, we plan to return to school for **4.00pm**. We will keep you informed of our ETA via Arbor, should we be delayed.

We would be grateful if you could contribute **£13.25** towards the cost of the booking. The cost of the visit is calculated by dividing the total amount by the number of children in the class/year group. Any outstanding money resulting from non-payments is paid for by school. However, as the school has limited funds to fall back on, we rely on the good will of parents/carers to ensure that the visit can take place. Otherwise under some circumstances it may be necessary to cancel the visit.

Payments must be made and permissions given on **Arbor**, please note all payments are non-refundable.
