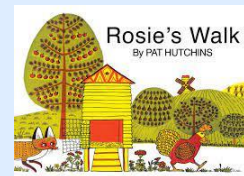
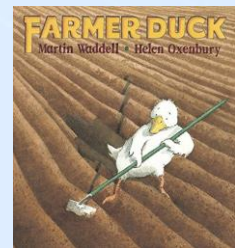


Literacy

As readers, we will continue to explore books in all areas of our classroom, using them to enhance and inspire our play. We will engage in conversations about stories to expand our vocabulary. We will also take part in activities to foster our love for reading during 'World Book Day' week.

As writers, we will focus on writing our names with more accuracy, using the Little Wandle letter formation to help us.

Maths



As mathematicians, we will develop our counting confidence by finding groups of objects to count and knowing that the final number is the total (cardinal principle). We will practise our subitising skills when we see an unfamiliar arrangement of objects and dots.

As we build using both large and small scale resources we will talk about the shapes and how they fit together. We will also learn to describe a familiar route and make simple maps.

Phonics

We will be learning the following sounds;

'u, r, h, b, f, l'

We will also be engaging in daily **Rhyme Time** sessions. games.

Other Areas of Learning



Communication and Language - As Speakers, we will begin using longer sentences when we talk, and use our phonics knowledge to help us to talk with increasing clarity. As Good Listeners, we will focus on being attentive and taking part in class discussions. We will join in with rhymes and talk to our friends as we play.

Physical Development - As Athletes, we will develop our ball skills outdoors, and learn how to use the balance bikes and balance boards. We will take part in team games and learn how to make up our own games and rules.

Understanding the World - As Geographers we will learn about the changing seasons as we move into spring, and observe the life cycle of a frog. We will plant seeds and watch them as they grow to find out what happens.

Expressive Arts and Design - As Creative People, we will make up our own versions of familiar nursery rhymes using the props in the music area. We will use the small world resources to create our own miniature farms and choose which animals will live there.
