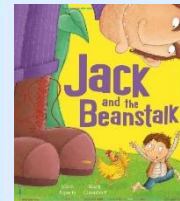
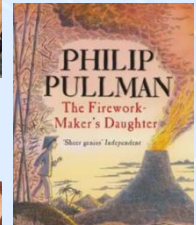

English

- As readers, the children will enjoy a range of different texts developing their understanding of what they have read.
- As Writers, the children in Year 6 will develop their skills towards writing a diary entry. They will include time adverbials, modal verbs and descriptive cohesion.
- 5 children will be exploring fronted adverbials, noun phrases and inverted commas. They will be working towards writing a newspaper article based on the Wolf's innocence.
- The Key Stage 1 room will be working towards writing an alternative ending to Jack and the Beanstalk. They will be focusing on including verbs and suffixes in their writing.

Maths



As Mathematicians, the children will:

- Year 6 will be focusing on fractions, decimals and percentages. Children are also practicing for SATs.
- Year 5 will be focusing on multiplication, division, subtraction and addition.
- The Key Stage 1 are working on securing their knowledge in place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division.

Science

As Scientists, the children will:

- Exploring the water cycle.
- We will be taking our experiments outdoors by looking at natural filtration and evaporation.

The Wider Curriculum



Geography –

We are exploring Rivers in the United Kingdom and around the world. We are linking our learning to science and the water cycle.

Art –

We are looking at various artists and exploring how to combine paint, drawing, sketching and sewing to build an imagine.

RE –

Children will explore the following questions: Key Stage 1 - Which books and stories are important? Year 5 and 6 – What do the Christians believe about the old and new covenants.

Music -

Sessions with Rock Steady – composing music using a range of different instruments. We are also beginning to explore singing in the class. KS2 are working on a sea shanty and KS1 are working toward signing ‘you’ve got a friend in me’.

Computing –

In computing we are looking at copyright and ownership. We will be exploring permissions, online content and acceptable use.
