How do I get about?

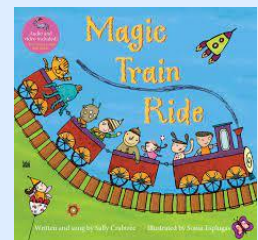
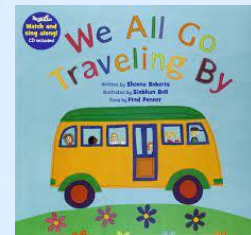


Literacy

As readers, we will engage in theme related songs and rhymes to further develop our love for books. We will talk about some of our favourite books we have read together this year.

As writers, we will focus on writing our names with accuracy and remembering to put our name on our work, using our name cards to help us. We will use our writing skills in our role play and as part of our outdoor learning.

Key text this half term



Maths



As mathematicians, we will grow our confidence in counting to 5 by choosing objects of a given number and writing the matching numeral.

Within our travel theme we will explore journeys and routes using tracks and vehicles and using positional language such as 'in front' and 'behind'. We will talk about how we travel to school and make simple maps of our journey.

Will select appropriate 2D shapes to create vehicle artwork and 3D shapes to build vehicle models in the block area.

Phonics

The children will learn to:

- Tune into sounds with the Little Wandle phonics scheme, focussing on the sounds **'ch ck x sh th ng nk'**
- Learn and sing nursery rhymes and engage in a variety of phonics games.

Other Areas of Learning



Communication and Language - As Speakers, we will develop our confidence when speaking to peers and adults. We will speak clearly when greeting others such as 'good morning' and 'thank you' and remember to ask for help when we need it. We will play theme related games to develop our communication and listening skills.

Physical Development - As Athletes, we will continue to learn how to play team games and take part in sports day. We will continue to develop our fine motor skills by engaging with threading and mark making activities indoors and outside.

Understanding the World – As Geographers we will explore the season of summer including how to keep ourselves safe when it is sunny. We will engage in our airport role play to gain a sense of other countries and talk about holidays that we have been on. We will explore why some vehicles are different and what they are used for.

Expressive Arts and Design – As Creative People, we will use our skills to create theme related artwork in a variety of ways such as large-scale junk modelling, collage and exploring making tracks with vehicles and paint. We will be imaginative and expressive with our role play when we explore different vehicles and what they are used for. We will use musical instruments to explore melody and rhythm.
