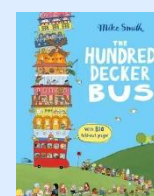
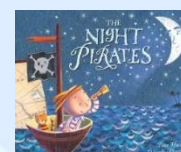
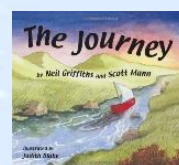
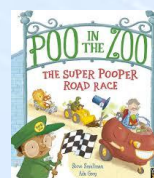
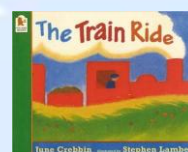


Literacy

As readers, we will practice re-read simple sentences to develop our early fluency, prosody and comprehension in group reading. We will also continue to share our excitement and enthusiasm towards drawing club as we explore a variety of texts linked to our theme. To develop our Reading for Pleasure we will be accessing our outdoor reading shed during learn and play time and bring home a book from the library each week.

As writers, we will continue to focus on independently writing simple sentences in our new themed writing area in a variety of narrative and non-narrative forms and re-read what we have written. We will also refine forming our upper-case and lower-case letters correctly.

Key text this half term



Maths



As mathematicians, we will consolidate counting verbally beyond 20, visualise, build, and map mathematical understanding. We will also consolidate in developing a deeper understanding of numbers to 10 and automatically recall number bonds to 5 and 10. We will further develop our knowledge and understanding of solving problems in different context. This half-term we will be encouraged to draw mathematically to demonstrate our understanding in a variety of ways. These mathematical drawings will also be added to our new math's floor book so that the children can demonstrate and talk about their learning.

Phonics

In phonics we will consolidate reading and spelling words in Phase 4 of Little Wandle 'Letters and Sounds Revised'. Decodable and tricky words will also be sent home at the beginning of the term for you to practice reading fluently.



Other Areas of Learning



Communication and Language

As good listeners, we will continue to focus on learning to listen attentively to stories from beginning to end. **As speakers**, we will make comments about what we have heard and ask questions to clarify our understanding. We will also learn to express our ideas and feelings about our life experiences using full sentences, including use of past, and present.

Understanding the World

As good citizens, we will focus on talking about events in our lives, such as, what we did during the holiday and celebrations. **As explorers**, we will focus on trains around the world, what trains were like in the past and observing and finding out all about summer.

Expressive Arts and Design

As creative people, we will focus on developing our art, design and technology, dance and singing skills through exploring and using a range of media and materials. In the studio we will be learning how to mix primary colours to make secondary colours when painting sunflowers and we will be using recycled materials to make different types of transport. **As imaginative people**, we will begin to represent our own ideas through art and role-play.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

As confident people, we will continue to try new activities and show independence, resilience, and perseverance in the face of a challenge. **As mindful people**, we will also be talking about our own feelings as we explore Year 1. As part of our SCARF learning we will be exploring growing and changing as we get ready to transition to Year 1.
